Block Party:

Discussion on the Block party that was tentatively scheduled for May 19. Unfortunately too many of the board members will not have enough time to prepare and help during that weekend. Also Navy said that the way it was done the last time the cost ended up being \$79 per person. Therefore the board decided to tone it down to a potluck dinner to keep the cost down. Previously tables were donated from Fiesta Rentals. Otherwise we will plan to get different neighbors to bring bbq for hotdogs and hamburgers and dishes. The block party is now tentatively planned for Saturday October 20, at the 1000 block of Golfview. Permit has to be applied for beginning of August.

Parrot in the Hood:

The May 18th and July 20th Parrot in the Hood and July 20th will be either at Dori and Aaron's Stibold's house or Anna's house. Anna will coordinate with Dori. Navy agreed tentatively to host the September 21st Parrot in the Hood.

Speaker Events:

April 24 is the next meeting with Phil as speaker. We have established a time limit for all speakers of 45 minutes. Navy will bring popcorn and Kris and Anna will bring cups and soda for this meeting.

Kris suggested using the movie "Inconvenient Truth" at a meeting and have a discussion on environmental issues. It was further suggested to invite a speaker from the recycling program or an environmental agency and then have a discussion what our neighborhood could do to help with environmental issues.

Another speaker event that had been discussed was reps from the city e.g. recreational, garbage, redevelopment agency. A lot of neighbors seem to have problems receiving a smaller garbage container.
