Joel Morgenstern spoke on crime prevention. The biggest crime right now is identity theft. Brochures of information were distributed. It is useful to have a shredding machine. He also mentioned that the city of Lake Worth is looking for people who are interested in participating in the citizens on patrol program. There is a 2 ½ hour training program given and a uniform and cell phone. You are then asked to volunteer for 2 hours a month. They need 2 people working together on this. Mr. Morgenstern said that crime is not on the increase in Lake Worth, but that it is always safer not to walk alone. People in groups rarely have incidents of crime. Car and home burglaries are less likely if doors are locked and things to steal are not visible.
